

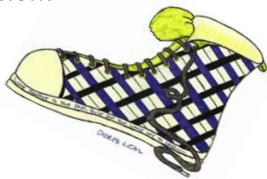


SUPPORTING ADDICTION RECOVERY

• **MARCH 24**

Graphic messages; creating a project instruction sheet for a T-shirt and companion writing project. Complete at home for the next class.

• **APRIL 7**

The Drug Court magazine. Create your own original project on any theme or topic to bring to the next class.

• **APRIL 14**

Project presentations in class.

• **APRIL 21**

The jail cell. Managing a presentation, writing and speaking topics.
