This fall a total of 1,427 classes were offered: 896 daytime, 288 evening, 226 distance learning, and 17 off-campus. The average class size is 19.

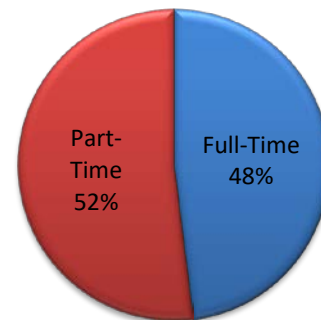
This semester 1,943 first-time students enrolled at CCM, of which 1,381 (71%) are recent high school graduates. These are the top five Morris County feeder high schools for students who graduated high school in 2017:

- Morris Knolls High School - 92
- Mount Olive High School - 82
- Roxbury High School - 80
- Morris Hills High School - 75
- Morristown High School - 70
