Academic Program (ESL)



- Gives students whose native language is not English the cultural and linguistic knowledge they need to complete a degree (Nursing, Hospitality Management, Humanities, etc.)
- Three levels
- 7 classes
- Students need a basic understanding of English in order to be admitted
- A placement test determines a student's level

Adult Program (ELL)

- The ELL (English Language Learning) Program, for limited English proficient adults, helps people increase their ability to communicate in English. Learners will acquire skills useful in the workplace, life and academics.
- With 4 different levels, there's something for everyone:
 - EARLY BEGINNER – for individuals with very limited English language skills
 - BEGINNER – the next step up, for individuals with slightly more proficiency
 - INTERMEDIATE – helps individuals improve their English language fluency and accuracy
 - ADVANCED – individuals acquire English skills to be more effective in the workplace or in academics
