In addition to general education courses, students are required to take courses in culture, geography, world literature, and four semesters of a world language.

WHY STUDY INTERNATIONAL STUDIES AT CCM?

Students enrolled in the International Studies Program have the opportunity to study abroad to enhance their course work. CCM, through its membership in the College Consortium for International Studies (CCIS), offers students the opportunity to study in twenty-four countries.
