

MATH - STANDARDIZED PLACEMENT TESTS

(Exemptions from non- credit/developmental Math courses)

Students are exempt from CCM's Math Accuplacer placement test and/or High School Transcript evaluation if minimum SAT, ACT, or NJSLA scores were met.

- **Math SAT** – 560 or higher
- **Math ACT** – 23 or higher
- **Algebra 2 NJSLA** - 4 or 5
