Take the Next Steps to Enroll and Register



REVIEW YOUR EMAIL ACCEPTANCE

Your email acceptance includes important information, such as your CCM Student Identification Number, your Program of Study/Major and any Placement Tests you may need to take before you can register for courses.

STEP 2

FINANCIAL PLANNING

Investing in your higher education is one of the wisest decisions you can make toward realizing your dreams for a rewarding life. As a degree or certificate seeking student, you may be eligible for financial aid, a scholarship or even free tuition to graduate CCM with little to no debt. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application if you are a New Jersey Dreamer prior to the registration period to see what financial aid you might be qualified to receive. COLLEGE READY PLACEMENT

Students seeking to earn a degree and for some certificates are placed into college credit mathematics and English courses through several different evaluation models – (1) submission of SAT, ACT or PARCC scores, (2) assessment of high school performance, (3) completion of previous college courses or (4) Accuplacer testing. Once placement steps have been completed, you will receive information about advisement and registration.



PREPARE FOR AND SCHEDULE A NEW STUDENT ADVISEMENT & REGISTRATION SESSION (NSAR)

Once all of your admission documentation is submitted and complete, you will receive an email to prepare for, and join an NSAR session with a Student Success Specialist (first-year advisor) from The Academic Success Center (TASC). Here, you will have the opportunity to understand how to plan and register for courses using Student Planning.



JOIN US FOR NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

Once you have registered for courses, you will receive an invitation, sent to your CCM student email, to attend a New Student Orientation, also known as FYI: First Year Information. The FYI program focuses on, among other things, acquainting you with different departments and services that will be especially helpful to you as a new CCM student.



SUBMIT YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

Immunization records are required for all full time students 30 years old and younger. Send your immunization records via email to health-services@ccm.edu. Any questions may be directed to 973-328-5170.



SUBMIT YOUR TUITION PAYMENT TO SECURE YOUR CLASS SCHEDULE

Tuition payments are due prior to the start of classes. View your account balance, financial aid, and submit your tuition payment on-line through Titan Direct. If you need assistance with a sponsorship or multiple forms of payment the Bursar staff is available to assist you in-person at the office. YOUR CCM ID CARD



Your CCM ID with photo serves as your primary form of official identification throughout the college. All students and employees are required to wear their college ID. To obtain an ID, you need to submit a photo of yourself to the Office of Campus Life, which you can do by emailing it to campuslife@ccm.edu. The image will be added to your Titans Direct account. When your CCM ID is ready to be picked up on campus, you will receive an email with instructions for obtaining your CCM ID.

PARKING AT CCM

CHARGEBACKS



Chargebacks are a process created by the State of New Jersey so out-of-county students are not penalized with higher or additional tuition costs for attending an out-of-county college if their home county college does not offer their chosen program of study/major. Students should inquire about chargebacks early in the enrollment process. Each college has different deadlines and cutoff dates to apply for chargebacks and submit the paperwork. Chargebacks must be initiated each semester.
