



RADIOGRAPHY PROGRAM — ADMISSION POLICY

1. Submit your application for admission (online or in person) and specify the Radiography major.
2. If you have previously taken classes here at CCM as a visiting student complete the "Request to Matriculate" form.
3. All previous college transcripts should be sent to Admission for review of eligible transfer credits. Please note: the Radiography Department DOES NOT EVALUATE TRANSCRIPTS.
4. Admission to the professional phase is competitive and based on a ranking system. The program typically receives more applications than the number of available seats. The program accepts 40 candidates for each Fall semester.
5. Completion of pre-requisites courses does not guarantee attendance into the professional phase of the program.
6. The following seven pre-requisite courses must be completed prior to being accepted into the professional phase of the program.

BIO 102	ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY 2	4 CREDITS *

*These science courses must be seven (7) years or less old at the time of acceptance into the Professional Phase of the Radiography Program.

7. Students must have an institutional (CCM) GPA of a 2.5 or greater to be considered.
8. The application for the program will be given at the information session and must be submitted by March 1st for the Fall semester.
9. All candidates MUST ATTEND A MANDATORY INFORMATION SESSION.
10. The mandatory information sessions start in June and are held once a month until February. A candidate only needs to attend one session. The dates, time and location of these sessions can be found on the Radiography Program webpage.
