If you did not take the Technology Literacy Competency test, you may schedule an appointment with the <u>CCM testing center</u>. Before doing so, consult with an Academic Advisor to confirm that your major requires additional testing in this subject matter and/or review the requirements for your major.

To do so, check the Progress tab on Student Planning from your <u>Titan's Direct account</u>. Consult with an academic advisor and/or check the recommendations on your <u>curriculum checksheet</u> for your major.

NOTES:

- Certain degree programs require a 1 4 credit technology literacy course, regardless of your score.
- Certain degree programs require a 1 4 credit technology literacy course if you do not pass the technology literacy competency test.
- Many degree programs have a technology literacy course embedded into the curriculum, and you will be required to take a technology course as part of your major.
- You may retake the Technology Literacy Competency test one week after you have taken the previous test. The fee to take the test is \$10.
