

#### Professors / Dean Emeritus / Emerita

The Latin title of Professor/Dean Emeritus (masculine singular) or Professor/Dean Emerita (feminine singular) is a special honor granted by the Board of Trustees of County College of Morris only to a very few faculty members and academic deans who have retired from full-time employment with the most outstanding, exemplary service records. The Latin root emerit means "earned by service."

The holder of such a title retains in the academic community a courtesy rank mirroring their active rank immediately before retirement.

Every Professor/Dean Emeritus/Emerita must have served the college for at least 15 years in a full-time position with faculty rank, and must have held the rank of full professor or academic dean at the time of retirement. Service must have been exemplary in terms of teaching or leadership, contributions to the college, and contributions to the larger professional and civic communities. The highest ethical standards must have been upheld in relationships with students, colleagues and superiors. The Emeritus (masculine plural) and Emerita (feminine plural) are considered "model" academic professionals.

#### **GEORGE MUHA**

**Big State Sports** 

A successful business leader and visionary with 18 years of entrepreneurial experience, George Muha is the founder and president of Big State Sports, a local, grassroots media company that provides network quality coverage of high school sports across New Jersey. Big State Sports reaches 5 million viewers weekly, broadcasting over 1,000 high school games annually with television rights to some of the biggest events in the state, including the Phil Simms North-South All-Star Game.

Muha is a 1996, County College of Morris Alumnus who earned his degree in Mass Communications and Media Studies. It was during his time at CCM

that Muha found his passion and talent for communication. Muha credits a CCM writing course, taught by Professor Emeritus Sander Zulauf, for revealing an ability for writing that has fueled his career in both the business and media industries.

His career started in logistics and supply chain consulting, and Muha quickly rose to the top as a thought leader, publishing articles in trade magazines and speaking at industry conferences. He launched successful businesses such as Freight Saving Tips (www.freightsavingstips.com), a blog and podcast venture that provided companies with money-saving ideas around logistics and supply chain issues as a way to share ideas, teach concepts, and interview experts to help listeners stay current in a quickly evolving industry.

Fifteen years ago, Muha discovered a new passion in sports media when he founded Morris Sussex Sports, a media company that provided coverage of more than forty high schools in Morris, Sussex and Warren Counties. What began as a hobby, quickly grew and became an innovative and dynamic way to be immersed in the community, while helping high school athletes connect to their fan base and supporters. Now known as Big State Sports, this leader is training the next generation of sports journalists and broadcasters through rewarding internships, plus introducing them to networking and job opportunities.

Muha has been featured in the college's Alumni Advocate, on its social media and other marketing initiatives. In 2019, he received the CCM Alumni Service Award in recognition of his outstanding service to CCM.

Since 2013, Muha has served as the Vice President of the Greater Morris Chapter of the National Football Foundation. He resides in Brookside with his family and has two children, daughter George and son Ben.

#### PROFESSOR NADIR KADDOUR, M.A.



Professor Nadir Kaddour joined the County
College of Morris faculty in 1988. He has taught
English as a Second Language (ESL), French
Language and Literature, and Intercultural
Communication.

Professor Kaddour earned a master's in education degree at New York University in 1979 and a Licence d'Anglais degree at the University of Algiers in 1975. In 1993, he received a fellowship to the Princeton University Community College Faculty Program. In 1999 and 2016, he was a recipient of the NISOD Excellence Award, which recognizes individuals doing extraordinary work on their campuses.

In addition to pursuing his passion for teaching, Professor Kaddour has held various positions at

CCM. He was chairperson of the Department of Languages and ESL from 1994 to 2004, as well as coordinator of the International Studies Program and the Study Abroad Program from 2004 to 2011. In 2013 and 2017, Professor Kaddour mentored doctoral candidates enrolled in a CCM-Drew University collaborative effort to provide college classroom experience to students enrolled in the Doctor of Letters Program at Drew University's Caspersen School of Graduate Studies.

Professor Kaddour's involvement in college affairs — and his commitment to community service — include chairing various standing College Council committees such as the Information Technology Committee, the Professional Affairs Committee, and the Safety Committee. He was faculty advisor to the Chi Alpha Epsilon Honor Society and The Promethean, CCM's student-produced literary and arts publication. He was a member of the board of trustees of Volunteers for Morris County and Literacy Volunteers of Morris County.

Professor Kaddour began his teaching career at the Institut National d'Électricité et d'Électronique in Algeria. He later joined Gas Development Corporation, a subsidiary of the Illinois Institute of Technology, at their Abu Dhabi campus in the United Arab Emirates. Upon returning to the United States, he taught ESL in Pennsylvania, at Harrisburg Area Community College and Northampton Community College.

#### THE SEAL:

- The lamp of learning cresting the shield represents the paramount purpose of the institution.
- The polaris and globe represent the guiding role which education plays in the world.
- The atomic symbol signifies the age in which we live, made possible by the accumulation of knowledge as represented by the book.
- The three orbits of the atomic symbol are the dimensions of the student's



- education at the college: intellectual, personal and social.
- The knight's helmet is excerpted from the official seal of Morris County and symbolizes the sponsorship of the college by the county.
- Three dividers on each side of the 1965 represent that New Jersey was the third of the original 13 states.
- "Sapere Aude" means "Dare to Know."

#### THE MACE:

The academic ceremonial mace is carried aloft and forward by the Grand Marshal in the academic procession. The mace incorporates the seal and is constructed of precious metals. It signifies protection of governmental, ecclesiastical or academic "authority."

#### **ACADEMIC APPAREL:**

#### The History of Academic Apparel

Ceremonial academic costumes symbolically link modern scholars with the oldest European universities, which in the Middle Ages required daily wearing of long, usually dark gowns by both faculty and students. In unheated medieval buildings, heavy gowns and hoods served not only protocol but practicality. The Renaissance brought color and ornament to academic attire. Some European costumes became elaborate and even today may include neck ruffs, capes and lampshade hats dripping with glass beads. Since about 1894, most U.S. colleges and universities have followed a common code for ceremonial garb. This code allows room for discretion, but its prescriptions for gown shape and hood design are precise and generally observed with care.

#### **Today's CCM Graduates Also Wear Sustainable Products**

Today, CCM graduates wear eco-friendly caps and gowns created from recycled plastic bottle caps, which are 100 percent made in the USA by Oak Hall. The light gray gown signifies the two-year associate degree or one-year certificate. Additional regalia such as stoles, cords and other ornaments symbolize the following:

Graduates have the option of keeping their regalia as a souvenir or placing them in the recycling bins provided after commencement.

#### **Faculty and Administration**

Gowns represent degree - bachelor, master or doctorate - and may be black or the authorized color of the degree-granting institution. For example, a New York University graduate may wear violet; a Rutgers, scarlet; or a Columbia, slate gray. Velvet trim on the gown and either a velvet hat or a gold tassel on the mortar board hat further distinguish a doctoral degree.

Shape of sleeve and length of hood are subtle but consistent indicators of the specific degree: pointed sleeve and 3-foot hood identify the bachelor; oblong sleeve with cutaway arc in front and 3.5-foot hood, master; bell-shaped sleeve and 4-foot hood, doctorate.


