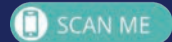

Application Checklist

- ☐ Complete the Admissions application and pay the \$30 fee.
- ☐ Provide your official high school transcript or a copy of your General Equivalency Diploma.
- ☐ Submit your transcripts from any other college or university you may have attended.
- ☐ Consider submitting your SAT/ACT scores. At CCM, this is optional but may exempt you from placement testing.
- ☐ We encourage you to submit your Admissions application and other documents several months before the start of a semester so you can register early and get the best choice of classes.
