



Articulation Agreement Between

Saint Elizabeth University

And

County College of Morris

This agreement outlines the terms of understanding between Saint Elizabeth University (SEU) and County College of Morris (CCM.) The focus of the agreement is a collaborative effort intended to facilitate the education of students in CCM's Associate of Applied Science - Paramedic Science program through the Bachelor of Science in Health Science degree at SEU. SEU also agrees to hold two spaces in its Master of Science in the Physician Assistant (MS in PA) program for interested applicants coming to SEU through this program articulation. Applicants are not guaranteed acceptance into the MS in PA program. They must meet acceptance requirements. This agreement is intended to create a Combined Educational Program which would culminate in the granting of a baccalaureate degree from SEU, an arrangement that will benefit the student, the County College of Morris, and Saint Elizabeth University.

The Program

SEU proposes a plan in which students from CCM will be able to transfer up to 90 credits toward the Bachelor of Science degree in Health Science.

A minimum of one hundred twenty (120) credits are needed for the Bachelor of Science degree completion. Students in the program will complete the remaining credits toward the 120 credits needed for the baccalaureate degree from courses offered at SEU. Participants must achieve grades of "C" or better in major courses for the baccalaureate program.

Provisional acceptance into the SEU BS in Health Science program will be granted to CCM AAS Paramedic Science program students upon their enrollment in the CCM program. Their formal acceptance will be guaranteed provided they meet SEU acceptance criteria upon completion of the CCM degree.


The Appendix lists the requirements for the AAS Degree in Paramedic Science at CCM with the additional requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Health Science (BS in HS) degree at Saint Elizabeth University.

Students coming through this articulation process who complete the SEU BS in HS will be guaranteed an interview if they apply to the SEU MS in the Physician Assistant program. SEU will hold two spaces in the SEU PA program for students who have completed the CCM Paramedics degree and an SEU bachelor's degree.

The Agreement

1. This agreement will be in force until dissolved or mutually modified.
2. This agreement may be cancelled by any party. Non-renewal notice must be given by February for cancellation the following year. The agreement may not be terminated during a semester.
3. The program directors shall communicate at least once a year to review the progress of the program.
4. All changes to the program proposed by either SEU or CCM should be submitted in writing to the other party at least six (6) months prior to the date proposed for the implementation of the suggested changes to the program. In the event the proposed changes are unacceptable, either party may terminate this agreement on six (6) months written notice. In the event of such a termination prior to the expiration of the term, the articulation program will continue in operation until all admitted students under this agreement have had an appropriate length of time to complete their studies.
5. Any scholarships and/or grants awarded by either institution will apply only to the courses offered by that institution.
6. SEU and CCM shall engage in equal opportunity in recruitment, admission, educational programs, and employment practices regardless of race, color, age, gender, disability, veteran status, marital status, religion, national origin, affectional or sexual orientation, genetic information, civil union status or domestic partnership, gender identity or expression or membership in any class protected by state or federal law.
7. Tuition and related costs, fees, and expenses for the CCM associate degree shall be paid to CCM and for the SEU baccalaureate degree shall be paid to SEU.


