Professors / Dean Emeritus / Emerita

The Latin title of Professor/Dean Emeritus (masculine singular) or Professor/Dean Emerita (feminine singular) is a special honor granted by the Board of Trustees of County College of Morris only to a very few faculty members and academic deans who have retired from full-time employment with the most outstanding, exemplary service records. The Latin root emerit means "earned by service."

The holder of such a title retains in the academic community a courtesy rank mirroring their active rank immediately before retirement.

Every Professor/Dean Emeritus/Emerita must have served the college for at least 15 years in a full-time position with faculty rank, and must have held the rank of full professor or academic dean at the time of retirement. Service must have been exemplary in terms of teaching or leadership, contributions to the college, and contributions to the larger professional and civic communities. The highest ethical standards must have been upheld in relationships with students, colleagues and superiors. The Emeritus (masculine plural) and Emerita (feminine plural) are considered "model" academic professionals.

Major General John T. Reim United States Army

Joint Program Executive Officer Armaments & Ammunition Commanding General, Picatinny Arsenal, New Jersey

Major General John T. Reim has served as the Joint Program Executive Officer Armaments & Ammunition and the Commanding General, Picatinny Arsenal since June 2022.

MG Reim is a native of Franklinville, NJ, and graduated from the U.S. Military Academy, West Point, NY in 1990 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering Management. He held a variety of leadership and staff positions within the 3rd Infantry Division, Germany and XVIII Airborne Corps, Fort Bragg, NC before entering the

Acquisition Corps. MG Reim's acquisition assignments include: Weapon Systems Acquisition Manager, U.S. Army Special Operations Command (USASOC); Deputy TRADOC System Manager for Battle Command, U.S. Army Combined Arms Center; Field Office Chief and Assistant Program Manager for Special Programs, USASOC Ground Applications Program Office (GAPO); Requirements and Programs Division Chief, later J8 Director and later Executive Officer, Joint Special Operations Command (JSOC); Program Manager Special Programs, USASOC GAPO; J8 Director, JSOC; Program Executive Officer (PEO) SOF Warrior, U.S. Special Operations Command; and Chief of Staff, Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics (ASA(ALT).

MG Reim's General Officer assignments include: Deputy for Acquisition and Systems Management, ASA(ALT); and Deputy Commander, Combined Security Transition Command - Afghanistan, later Deputy Director, and later Director, Defense Security Cooperation Management Office - Afghanistan.

MG Reim's professional education includes the Quartermaster Officer Basic Course, the Combined Logistics Officer Advanced Course, the Command and General Staff Officer Course, the U.S. Army War College's National Security Fellowship at UNC-Chapel Hill, the Defense Acquisition University Executive Program Manager's Course, and the Senior Acquisition Leader Development Program. He is a Level III certified acquisition professional in the Program Management career field and holds a Master of Arts degree in Procurement and Acquisitions Management from Webster University.

MG Reim's military awards include: the Defense Superior Service Medal (2 OLC), the Legion of Merit (1 OLC), the Defense Meritorious Service Medal (1 OLC), the Meritorious Service Medal (3 OLC), the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Army Commendation Medal (1 OLC), Joint Service Achievement Medal, and the Army Achievement Medal (1 OLC). His decorations include: the Parachutist Badge, the Parachute Rigger Badge, Brazilian & Australian Parachutist Badges, the Army Staff Identification Badge, and the Order of Saint Martin. MG Reim and his wife Patty are the proud parents of four children, who form the core of "Team Reim!"

ALEXIS THURMAN, M.B.A., M.S.



Professor Alexis Thurman joined County
College of Morris faculty in 1992. She has
taught courses in Mathematics, Information
Technologies and Business Administration
at CCM, and has been chairperson of the
Department of Mathematics since 2014.

In addition to pursuing her passion for teaching, Professor Thurman has held other positions at the college, including director of the Summer Academy for Young Scholars from 1993 to 2015, director of the Center for Teaching Excellence, and chairperson of the Department of Business.

Professor Thurman's involvement in college affairs and her commitment to community service include co-chairing the Bildner Project

and serving on the Academic Integrity Review Board from 2004 to 2006. She has participated in College Council, Technology Task Force, Disabilities Awareness, Women Who Dare, Curriculum and Middle States committees. She also led math review sessions for EOF Summer Orientation at CCM and the Neighborhood House in Morristown.

Professor Thurman began her teaching career at the Irvington Board of Education in New Jersey. She later joined Johnson & Johnson as a programmer and then continued to Warner Lambert as a programmer analyst, a systems analyst and lastly a data analyst. Upon leaving Corporate America, she returned to teaching and is now celebrating her 33rd year at CCM.

Professor Thurman earned a Master of Science in Applied Science (Mathematics Applied to Computer Science) at New Jersey Institute of Technology, 1982 and a Master of Business Administration (Quantitative Analysis) at Seton Hall University, 1988. She received a fellowship to Princeton University's Community College Faculty program in 2004 and served as an adjunct for Fairleigh Dickinson University's Executive MBA Health Systems Management program. In 1996 and 2022, she was a recipient of the NISOD Excellence Award, which recognizes individuals doing extraordinary work on their campuses.

THE SEAL

- The lamp of learning cresting the shield represents the paramount purpose of the institution.
- The polaris and globe represent the guiding role which education plays in the world.
- The atomic symbol signifies the age in which we live, made possible by the accumulation of knowledge as represented by the book.
- The three orbits of the atomic symbol are the dimensions of the student's



- education at the college: intellectual, personal and social.
- The knight's helmet is excerpted from the official seal of Morris County and symbolizes the sponsorship of the college by the county.
- Three dividers on each side of the 1965 represent that New Jersey was the third of the original 13 states.
- "Sapere Aude" means "Dare to Know."

THE MACE

The academic ceremonial mace is carried aloft and forward by the Grand Marshal in the academic procession. The mace incorporates the seal and is constructed of precious metals. It signifies protection of governmental, ecclesiastical or academic "authority."

ACADEMIC APPAREL

The History of Academic Apparel

Ceremonial academic costumes symbolically link modern scholars with the oldest European universities, which in the Middle Ages required daily wearing of long, usually dark gowns by both faculty and students. In unheated medieval buildings, heavy gowns and hoods served not only protocol but practicality. The Renaissance brought color and ornament to academic attire. Some European costumes became elaborate and even today may include neck ruffs, capes and lampshade hats dripping with glass beads. Since about 1894, most U.S. colleges and universities have followed a common code for ceremonial garb. This code allows room for discretion, but its prescriptions for gown shape and hood design are precise and generally observed with care.

Faculty and Administration

Gowns represent degrees — bachelor, master or doctorate — and may be black or the authorized color of the degree-granting institution. For example, a New York University graduate may wear violet; a Rutgers, scarlet; or a Columbia, slate gray. Velvet trim on the gown and either a velvet hat or a gold tassel on the mortar board hat further distinguish a doctoral degree.

Shape of sleeve and length of hood are subtle but consistent indicators of the specific degree: pointed sleeve and 3-foot hood identify the bachelor; oblong sleeve with cutaway arc in front and 3.5-foot hood, master; bell-shaped sleeve and 4-foot hood, doctorate.

The ornamental hood worn draped from the shoulders is always lined with the color of the degree-granting institution. Velvet binding on the hood is in a color signifying the wearer's discipline or subject:

- Apricot

Graduates have the option of keeping their regalia as a souvenir.
