+All students must complete a dance placement evaluation with a dance faculty member or register for DAN 117 Intro to Ballet or DAN 111 Intro to Dance and receive a grade of C or better to register for DAN 137 Ballet I and DAN 141 Modern I. Can be counted as a dance elective.

++Requires active enrollment in Dance Technique classes to be enrolled and participate in DAN 135, DAN 136, DAN 220, DAN 222 Dance Theatre Workshop I-IV and dance productions.

**GENERAL EDUCATION ELECTIVE:** It is strongly suggested that to broaden your musical background as it pertains to dance studies and choreography, students take any one of the Music courses listed on the Humanities section of the General Education list.

**DIVERSITY ELECTIVE:** It is strongly suggested that to broaden your musical background as it pertains to dance studies and choreography, students take one of the following electives: MUS 114 American Music, MUS 143 World Music & Culture, MUS 163 Rock History & Culture or MUS 248 Enjoyment of Music as your Diversity elective.

**TECHNOLOGY:**

Students must pass the Technology Literacy Competency Test or take CMP 101, Computer Information Literacy (1 CR) to fulfill graduation requirements.

**DANCE ELECTIVE:** Students may choose between DAN 125 Jazz I, DAN 126 Jazz II, DAN 130 Tap I or DAN 146 Dance for Musical Theatre. Students who are required to take either DAN 111 Introduction to Dance or DAN 117 Introduction to Ballet may count these as a dance elective.

**HONORS COURSES:** You may be eligible to take honors courses. Discuss this option with your Academic Advisor.
