- The application for acceptance to the professional phase of the program is a separate application from the CCM application.
- You may contact the Program Director, Andrea Murray at amurray@ccm.edu, to obtain an application for the professional phase of the program.
- Acceptance into the professional phase of the program is competitive (based on academic performance) and is NOT guaranteed once pre-requisites are complete.

To be eligible for consideration for admission to the professional phase of the program, students must:

- Complete and submit the Paramedic Science professional phase application.
- Hold and maintain current New Jersey EMT and AHA BLS Healthcare Provider (CPR) certifications and a valid driver's license.
- Be a minimum of 18 years of age by the first day of PAR 120.
