All Teacher Education students are required to see their Academic Track Advisor or Teacher Education Advisor each semester to discuss and approve their selection of courses before they register. Due to continual program revisions mandated by accrediting agencies and/or changes in state mandated requirements, students should consult their academic advisor when selecting courses.

Students pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in Education need a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to satisfy NJ Department of Education requirements. To determine the transferability of your courses to participating NJ Colleges & Universities visit the NJ Transfer site at www.njtransfer.org. GPA requirements for Education degrees vary. If you are planning to transfer contact the institution for admissions requirements.

Teacher Education Core Note:

To enroll in EDU 111 and EDU 211 students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and permission of the Department Chairperson, Assistant Chairperson, or advisor (via petition).

***BIO 101 & BIO 102 are prerequisites for HES 212. HES 212 is a prerequisite for HES 213. Minimum passing grade of "C" is required in HES 212.
