This fall a total of 1,389 classes were offered: 845 daytime, 259 evening, 237 distance learning, and 19 off-campus. The average class size is 18.

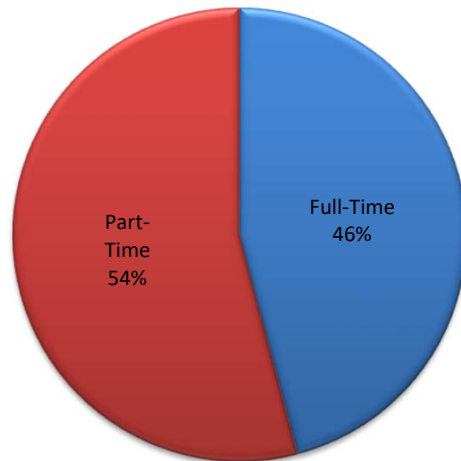
This semester 1,855 first-time students enrolled at CCM, of which 1,294 (70%) are recent high school graduates. These are the top five Morris County feeder high schools for students who graduated high school in 2019:

- Roxbury High School - 99
- Mount Olive High School - 84
- Morris Hills High School - 86
- Parsippany Hills High School - 66
- Dover HS - 93

The following programs have the most first-time and new transfer students enrolled:

- Business Administration - 287
- Nursing - 241
