

Articulation Agreement
Between
College of Saint Elizabeth
And
County College of Morris

This agreement outlines the terms of understanding between the College of Saint Elizabeth (CSE) and County College of Morris (CCM.) The focus of the agreement is a collaborative effort intended to facilitate the education of students in CCM's Associate in Applied Science in Nursing through the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree at CSE. The agreement is intended to create an arrangement that will benefit the student, the County College of Morris, and the College of Saint Elizabeth.

The Program

CSE proposes a plan in which students from CCM will be able to transfer up to 90 credits from CCM toward the Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing.

A minimum of one hundred twenty (120) credits are needed for the Bachelor of Science degree completion. Students in the program will complete the remaining credits toward the 120 credits needed for the baccalaureate degree from courses offered at CSE. Participants must achieve grades of "C" or better in major courses for the baccalaureate program.

Student transcripts are evaluated. All transferable credits are accepted up to ninety (90) credits. Additional courses that may be required if not already taken are:

- CHEM 123 or FN 201 or PHY 149 (3-4 credits) *These requirements can be met at CCM: CHM 210, HED 115, or PHY 103*
- MAT 119 (4 credits)
- PHIL 331 (3 credits) Equivalent may be taken at CCM Bio 118 Biomed. Ethics
- Element III (4 credits; must be taken at CSE)

The nursing courses, totaling twenty eight (28) credits, taken at CSE are as follows:

- NURS 300 (3 credits)
- NURS 310 (3 credits)
- NURS 320 (3 credits)
- NURS 330 (3 credits)
- NURS 340 (3 credits)
- NURS 350 (3 credits)
- NURS 400 or NURS 410 (5 credits)
- NURS 420 (5 credits)

- NURS Elective (3 credits) *This course elective can also be met at CCM NUR220 Pharmacology for the Health Professional*

Under this agreement, CCM students will be matriculated at CSE once they have earned their AAS in Nursing, have an active license to practice as a Registered Nurse in New Jersey, and have been accepted by CSE, using CSE standards.

Once accepted, students will be required to meet all CSE and Nursing Program requirements. These include background checks and health requirements.

Appendix A lists the requirements for the Associate Degree in Applied Science – Nursing at CCM with the additional requirements for the BSN degree at the College of Saint Elizabeth.

The Agreement

1. This agreement will be in force until dissolved or mutually modified.
2. This agreement may be cancelled by any party. Non-renewal notice must be given by February for cancellation the following year. The agreement may not be terminated during a semester.
3. The heads of the programs shall communicate at least once a year to review the progress of the program.


