Course Guide: Students completing an AS in Business Administration should follow their curriculum check sheet and use this guide in selecting courses.

Recommendations:

- Mathematics Electives – Take **MAT 110 & MAT 124** or **MAT 130**
- CCM Business Administration courses: **ACC 111, ACC 112, BUS 215, MKT 113, ECO 211, ECO 212, and BUS 119** are equivalent to required major courses.
- Lab Science Elective – Choose from BIO 132, **BIO 127** (recommended), PHY 118, **SCI 118** (recommended)
- History Electives – **HIS 113 & 114** (recommended) OR HIS 117 & 118
- Literature or Language – Language sequence recommended.
- Business Administration Electives – Take **BUS 213**. It is recommended to choose additional electives based on concentration. Accounting – ACC 211 & 212 Management – BUS 219 & BUS 135 Entrepreneurship – BUS 219. Additional electives with direct equivalent: ACC 211, ACC 212, ACC 215, BUS 135, BUS 136, BUS 201, BUS 212, BUS 213, BUS 218, BUS 219
- Free Elective – Take **COM 109** Speech Fundamentals or **PSY 113** General Psychology
