- Social Science/ Humanities Elective take ECO 212 Principles of Microeconomics
- General Education Elective Recommendations (choose one) take POL 111 American Government, PSY 113 General Psychology, COM 109 Speech Communications
- If the Cooperative Work Experience (**HOS 223**) is not taken at CCM, it will have to be done at FDU.
