ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT
FAIRLEIGH DICKINSON UNIVERSITY
AND
THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION
COUNTY COLLEGE OF MORRIS

The International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management, part of Petrocelli College at Fairleigh Dickinson University and County College of Morris agree to mutual cooperation in establishing and maintaining articulation of our respective academic programs for the A.A.S. Degree in Hospitality Management Restaurant and Culinary Management Option and the Bachelor of Arts in Individualized Studies with a specialization in Hospitality Management. The principal beneficiaries of this agreement are students whose progress toward their degrees is best assured when they are provided with current arrangements between institutions, which provide the opportunity of planning a total baccalaureate degree program at the outset of their college education.

This articulation agreement between the International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management of Petrocelli College at Fairleigh Dickinson University and County College of Morris will become effective October 23, 2009. The International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management of Petrocelli College at Fairleigh Dickinson University and County College of Morris will provide students in its program with all information, including the complete list of course equivalencies pertaining to this agreement. The agreement and equivalencies will be reviewed annually.

PRINCIPLES OF AGREEMENT

Program Completion

Transfer students from County College of Morris will be required to meet all graduation requirements as listed for Fairleigh Dickinson University students.

Specific Requirements

The determination of program requirements for the International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management of Petrocelli College shall be the responsibility of the International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management of Petrocelli College at Fairleigh Dickinson University.

Eligibility

Transfer students are eligible for admission to the International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management of Petrocelli College at Fairleigh Dickinson University upon completion

of the A.A.S. Degree in Hospitality Management Restaurant and Culinary Management Option from County College of Morris with a minimum of 2.0 overall averages on a four-point scale. The International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management reserve the right to decline admission to students who have earned grades below C. The purpose of this requirement is to insure consistency. That is, college students transferring to the International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management of Petrocelli College at Fairleigh Dickinson University will be treated as native Fairleigh Dickinson University students.

Feedback and Follow-up

The International School of Hospitality and Tourism Management of Petrocelli College at Fairleigh Dickinson University and County College of Morris will assign a staff person to serve as a liaison to assure maintenance of communication between the two institutions.


Additional Information

Graduates from CCM, having earned the Hospitality Management or Culinary Management degrees will be able to earn their baccalaureate degree requirements of 120 credits, in Individualized Studies with a Specialization in Hospitality Management from Fairleigh Dickinson University by completing the remaining 56 credits needed to graduate, provided they have taken the exact CCM courses designated in the agreement between CCM and FDU. Once arriving at FDU students will follow their advisor's direction regarding the completion courses listed on their BAIS check sheet, which is provided to them upon admittance into the program. The credits transferred from CCM into the baccalaureate program will apply toward the total required credits for degree completion at FDU.




