



Application for Full-Tuition Scholarship to Drew University

Drew University awards two scholarships to graduates of the County College of Morris (CCM) who have excelled academically and who wish to transfer to the University. Candidates must submit a FAFSA and apply for the New Jersey Tuition Assistance Grant (TAG) program. Funds from the TAG program will be combined with a scholarship from Drew to cover full tuition at the University.

Candidates who anticipate graduating or will have graduated from CCM with an Associate of Arts degree, have earned a minimum final GPA of 3.8, and wish to enroll at Drew as a full-time matriculating student are encouraged to apply. Applicants may be nominated by one of the following CCM administrators: President, Vice President of Academic Affairs, Vice President for Student Development and Enrollment Management, Dean of Students, a Division Dean, or the Coordinator of Transfer Programs. In addition, applicants must submit an essay detailing their past accomplishments, future goals, and what contributions he/she would bring to the Drew community. The applicant’s nomination and essay will be submitted to Sunita Bhargava, Director of Transfer and Continuing Education. The deadline for submitting applications for the fall semester is March 15. For the spring semester, the deadline is October 15. All information should be sent to the attention of Ms. Bhargava in the Office of College Admissions, Drew University, 36 Madison Ave., Madison, NJ 07940.
