Terms of the Agreement:

Cumulative GPA: 2.0 Overall Grade Point Average is required for admission to WPU College of Science and Health

Transfer Credit: WPU will accept all degree credits, 63. Students can transfer half of credits required for the major.

New Jersey State-Wide Agreement Eligibility: Students with an Associate in Science degree will have completed their general education (University Core Curriculum) requirements when transferring into Bachelor of Science at William Paterson University under the SWTA.

Graduation Requirements: To fulfill the William Paterson University Requirements students must have 6 credits of Foreign Language.

Course Guide: Students completing an AS in Criminal Justice should follow their curriculum check sheet and use this guide in selecting elective courses.

Recommendations:

- Take **two** semesters of **one** Foreign Language (American Sign Language can also fulfill the requirement) as Humanities Elective and General Education Elective.
- Take either **BIO 121 & 122** General Biology 1 &2 or **CHM 125/126 & 127/128** General Chemistry 1 & 2, or **PHY 125/126 & PHY 127/128** as Laboratory Science Electives.
- MAT 132, CMP 128, CMP 129, CMP 230, CMP 233, CMP 246 are equivalent to required major courses.
- CMP 123 is an elective course.
