

## AA, AS, & AFA in Teacher Education to BA Degrees in Education

## **Terms of the Agreement:**

**CCM Education Specializations Include:** Biology, Chemistry, English, Health/Physical Education, Mathematics, History, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, Visual Arts

**Cumulative GPA:** <u>3.0</u> Cumulative Grade Point Average for admission to WPU College of Education and 3.0 to take 3000 level education courses. Students must maintain a 3.0 in their education major at WPU to continue.

Additional Entrance Requirements: Students must pass the <u>Praxis Core</u> Academic Skills for Educators.

Transfer Credit: Students can transfer half of credits required for the major.

**New Jersey State-Wide Agreement Eligibility:** Students with an Associate in Science or Associate in Arts degree will have completed their general education (University Core Curriculum) requirements when transferring into Bachelor of Arts at William Paterson University under the SWTA.

**Graduation Requirements:** To fulfill the William Paterson University Requirements students must have 6 credits of Foreign Language.

**Course Guide:** Students completing an AS in Exercise Science should follow their curriculum check sheet and use this guide in selecting elective courses.

## **Recommendations:**

- Early Childhood Education P-3 & Elementary Education K-6 students should take two math courses, American History (HIS 166 & 167), and two sciences courses. Take MAT 120, 110, 124, and/or 130 as the mathematics elective.
- Take **two** semesters of **one** Foreign Language as the Humanities elective and a General Education elective (American Sign Language can also fulfill the requirement).
- Teacher Education Specialization: EDU 111 Teaching in America & EDU 211 Behavior Observation are equivalent to required course - Teaching as a Profession CIED 2030, PSY 217 Educational Psychology is equivalent to required course - Educational Psychology CISE 2950.
- Take **SOC 214** Cultural Diversity in America as Diversity or free elective check with faculty advisor for recommendation or possible subsitution.
