AS in Science & Mathematics – Mathematics to BS in Mathematics, BA in Mathematics

Terms of the Agreement:

Cumulative GPA: 2.0 Overall Grade Point Average is required for admission to WPU College of Science and Health

Transfer Credit: WPU will accept all degree credits 60/62. Students can transfer half of credits required for the major.

New Jersey State-Wide Agreement Eligibility: Students with an Associate in Science degree will have completed their general education (University Core Curriculum) requirements when transferring into Bachelor of Science at William Paterson University under the SWTA.

Graduation Requirements: To fulfill the William Paterson University Requirements students must have 6 credits of Foreign Language.

NJ Transfer: Course-to-course equivalencies are available on NJ Transfer at www.njtransfer.org.

Course Guide: Students completing an AS in Mathematics should follow their curriculum check sheet and use this guide in selecting elective courses.

Recommendations:

- Take **MAT 232 Differential Equations** as General Education, Core, Free, or Restricted Elective.
- Take **MAT 228 Linear Algebra** as General Education, Free, Math or Restricted Elective.
- Take **two** semesters of **one** Foreign Language (American Sign Language can also fulfill the requirement) as Humanities electives.
- Take **PHY 125/126 & PHY 127/128** General Physics 1 & 2 as Laboratory Science sequence.
- **MAT 123, MAT 131, MAT 132, MAT 230** are equivalent to required pre-requisite and major courses.
