UPPER LEVEL ELECTIVES (9 credits)

Two required Upper Level electives for Accounting majors are ECON355 (1.5 credits) and MGT 350 (1.5 credits). CCM students are advised to take Elective coursework that can be transferred as Upper Level electives for the remaining six (6) credits.

Non-Western Requirement

WPU students are required to take one course (3 credits) from an approved list of Non-Western courses. A Non-Western course can be taken to simultaneously satisfy another degree requirement (e.g., General Education elective or Upper Level elective).

The total number of credits that may be transferred to WPU is 70. It is possible that a CCM student will be able to transfer in credits in excess of those listed in the articulation agreement but careful selection will be necessary to insure that the courses meet WPU requirements.

Special Requirements and Comments:

- WPU College of Business students are required to take POL 110 as one of the social sciences. While CCM's POL 111 transfers as POL 120 to WPU, it cannot be used to substitute for POL 110.
- CCM's "Introduction to Business" (BUS 112) is *not* transferable as business course to WPU.
- While CCM's BUS 213 will transfer as WPU's LAW 201, CCM students should be advised against taking that course since Accounting students are required to take LAW 251 which substitutes for LAW 201.
