Additional General Education Requirements

- 9 credits in Upper Level electives (any non-major course 200 level or above)

Major Requirements

The **William Paterson University** Asian Studies Program requires 30 credits to be completed in the field.

Required Major courses: *ASN 201* Introduction to Asian Studies; *ASN 480* Asian Studies Senior Seminar; *ASN 270* Civilization of East Asia for East Asia Track or *ASN 280* Civilization of South Asia for South Asia Track.

Major Courses

Up to 5 courses, or 15 credits, can transfer into the major in Asian Studies from County College of Morris with the grade of "C" or higher
