English Major Requirements

The English major at William Paterson University requires 36 credits. Students concentrate in literature or writing; majors from both concentrations can apply for teaching certification with a 2.75 GPA. Students can transfer in a maximum of 5 courses in the major for which they have received a grade of C or higher.

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These 4 courses are among the required courses for the major (Four surveys required for lit. concentration—at least 1 British, American, and Western European. Two surveys are required for writing concentration).
