Additional General Education Requirements

Other G.E. Requirements at WPU include:

- 6 credits of G E Electives. Choose 2 course sequence in U.S. History.
- 3 credits in Non-Western—this requirement may be fulfilled by a required course in the Geography major.
- 9 credits in Upper Level electives (any non-major course 200 level or above); Choose 3 courses outside of Geography which are above 100 level. Some of these may be taken to fulfill Social Studies Core (see below).

Major Requirements

William Paterson University's major in Geography requires 34 credits. Up to 3 credits can transfer into the major in Geography from County College of Morris with the grade of "C" or higher.

Special Requirements and comments:

- Students transferring to the Geography program at William Paterson University are expected to complete all 59 credits in General Education required courses.
- Electives to complete a total of 128 credits may be required for graduation.

Social Studies Core (see chart below): In addition to courses in the major and courses in Education, students pursuing Social Studies Subject Area Teaching Certification are required take courses in the following content areas in order to fulfill the Social Studies Standards. These required courses may be fulfilled within the General Education program, GE electives, upper level electives, and in some cases, as part of the major.
