## Update on Safety Plans for the Fall Semester

At the start of the Fall 2020 Semester, less than 25 percent of instruction will be held on campus and many employees will continue to work remotely. One of the many measures that will be in place to protect the health and safety of those who are on campus will be Temperature Screening Stations, located at designated building entrances. Some parking lots and building entrances will be closed to better direct individuals to the screening stations. Signage will be in place to direct you. At these locations, college staff will confirm that anyone entering a building is wearing a mask, is wearing a college identification card and does not have a fever over 100 degrees. All building exits will remain unlocked, allowing those on campus to leave a building as soon as possible. Visitors will be managed in a similar fashion and given a temporary identification card.

More details on the Return to Campus Plan will be shared in the coming week but know that college officials are working hard to ensure your safety. Please be prepared to wear your CCM identification card at all times when on campus. ## The Campus Store

The Campus Store will be open for in-person business again beginning August 31 with the following restrictions:

- Occupancy will be capped at 30 customers at a time
- The textbook section will not be open for browsing (counter service only)
- Students must have course and section schedule information as the store cannot fulfill requests by title
- Clothing is not available for fittings (counter service only)

To ensure materials are available in time for the start of class, the Campus Store recommends ordering online at [bookstore.ccm.edu](http://bookstore.ccm.edu) before August 31. On-campus pickup will be available outside the Student Community Center. Pickup directions will be sent with the order confirmation.
