### New Students Arriving Soon

The CCM community is looking forward to having more students on campus soon. New students will be arriving starting in early August to take part in "FYI: First Year Information," an interactive New Student Orientation program.

This program is held during select Tuesdays and Thursdays in August. During FYI, new students learn about the different CCM departments that will be especially helpful to them during their first few weeks on campus. They also get to hear from CCM faculty and returning and former students, who share their insights on being a CCM student. The New Student Orientation program is offered in three formats: Traditional, Lecture Style and Virtual.

**Traditional** – Small groups of 10 to 20 new students, grouped by academic area, will tour the campus with an orientation leader. Those programs take place:

- Thursday, August 4, 12:30 to 3:30 p.m.
- Thursday, August 11, 12:30 to 3:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, August 16, 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**Lecture Style** – New students who select this option will meet together in Dragonetti Auditorium on Tuesday, August 23, 9:30 to 11:30 a.m.

**Virtual** – These remote programs include both an information session and a Student Leader Lounge where new students can ask questions. Two have been scheduled for Tuesday, August 9, and Thursday, August 18.

Be sure to give a warm welcome to any student you may see on campus and remember classes this year begin Wednesday, August 31.
