This fall a total of 1,290 classes were offered: 442 daytime, 137 evening, 701 distance learning, and 1 off-campus. The average class size is 17.

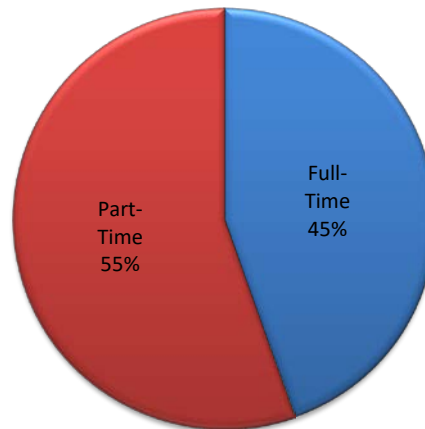
This semester 1,855 first-time students enrolled at CCM, of which 1,658 (70%) are recent high school graduates. These are the top five Morris County feeder high schools for students who graduated high school in 2020:

- Morris Knolls High School - 97
- Mount Olive High School - 83
- Morris Hills High School - 77
- Roxbury High School - 67
- Dover HS - 59

The following programs have the most first-time and new transfer students enrolled:

- Business Administration - 262
- Nursing - 229
- Humanities Social Science - 227
- Criminal Justice - 122
- Biology - 94
