****All students must pass a theory placement exam or register for MUS 011 Basic Musicianship and MUS 176 Aural Comprehension. All students must receive a **grade of “C” or higher in MUS 011 in order to register for MUS 117.**

It is strongly suggested that in order to broaden your musical background and for future placement and auditions, consider taking the following electives:

- DAN 111 Introduction to Dance
- DAN 117 Introduction to Ballet
- DAN 125 Jazz I
- MUS 237-238 Cabaret Musical Theatre I-IV
- MUS 110, 209, 210 Applied Music Secondary Voice II, III, IV

Any student who receives a grade of ‘D’ in any music course must repeat the course and is required to see the Music Department Chairperson before registering for their next semester.
