There are two phases of the Paramedic Science Program - Pre-professional and Professional. Application for acceptance to the professional phase of the program is a separate application from the CCM application. Contact the Program Director, Andrea Murray to obtain an application for the professional phase. Acceptance into the professional phase of the program is competitive (based on academic performance) and NOT guaranteed once pre-requisites are complete.

\*BIO 102 is a pre or co-requisite of PAR 120.

**\*\*To be eligible for consideration for admission to the professional phase of the program students must:**

- Complete and submit the Paramedic Science professional phase application.
- Hold and maintain current New Jersey EMT and AHA BLS Healthcare Provider (CPR) certifications and a valid driver's license.
- Be a minimum of 18 years of age by the first day of PAR 120.
