MATHEMATICS: See attached General Education course list. Work closely with your advisor to select the appropriate courses. Students must selectat least one 3/4 credit Math course. **Note:** Students will not receive credit towards graduation for more than one of the following courses: MAT 124, Statistics and MAT 130, Probability and Statistics.

SCIENCE: See attached General Education course list. Work closely with your advisor to select the appropriate courses. Students must select at leastone 4 credit Laboratory Science course.

TECHNOLOGY LITERACY: If you pass the Technology Literacy Competency Placement test, you are <u>not required</u> to take a Technology course, although you may do so if you choose. If you do not pass the test, you must take 1-4 credits of General Education Technology. Select from these courses: CMP 101 (1 CR), CMP 126 (4 CR), CMP 128 (3 CR), CMP 131 (3 CR) or CMP 135 (3 CR).

HISTORY (6 CR): Choose any two History courses from the General Education course list (under Humanities).

HUMANITIES: Choose two, three-credit Music classes from the General Education course list. Choices include: MUS 114 American Music, MUS 143 World Music and Culture, MUS 150 Jazz History & Styles, MUS 163 Rock History & Culture, MUS 217 Music History & Literature to 1750, MUS 218 Music History & Literature from 1750, MUS 248 Enjoyment of Music, MUS 258 Contemporary Music: $20^{th} - 21^{st}$ Century.

DIVERSITY ELECTIVE: Choose one, three credit Music class from the General Education Diversity list. Choices include: MUS 114 American Music, MUS 143 World Music and Culture, MUS 163 Rock History & Culture, MUS 248 Enjoyment of Music.

HONORS COURSES: You may be eligible to take honors courses. Discuss this option with your Academic Advisor.
