CCM board of trustees reappointed

The Morris County Board of Chosen Freeholders reappointed County College of Morris Board of Trustees Elaine Johnson and Joseph Longo, P.E. for another four-year term which ends Oct. 31, 2011. One more position still remains open, which freeholders have yet to fill.



Trustee Johnson of Kenvil, who currently serves as vice chair, was originally appointed to the CCM board in April 1999. She manages the Transitional Housing Program and Jean Street Affordable Housing Project for Homeless Solutions Inc. in Morris Township. She has served two years as board secretary and three years as treasurer.

Trustee Longo of Morristown, who currently serves as secretary, was originally appointed to the CCM board in January 2006. He is a long-time resident of Morris County and the retired President and CEO of Longo Industries in Wharton. He has been active in the community for many years, having served on boards such as the Morris County Chamber of Commerce, the Morris County Construction Board of Appeals, and the Morris/Sussex/Warren Workforce Investment Board.



The board also passed a \$61.9 million operating budget for the 2008/2009 fiscal year, which runs from July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. The budget increased one percent above the 2007/08 budget. The county funded portion of the budget will be presented to the Board of School Estimate in February. CCM will ask the county for \$12,757,356.
