## Bequest Aids Nursing Scholarship at County College of Morris

A \$250,000 bequest from the estate of Helen M. Bauer will be added to the George and Helen M. Bauer Nursing Scholarship at the County College of Morris, bringing the total endowment of the scholarship to \$275,957.

The scholarship, which was established in 2002, supports full-time nursing students who have successfully completed their first semesters with a 3.0 academic average. The award recognizes academic achievement and professional potential as determined by the nursing department faculty in conjunction with the County College of Morris Foundation and the Financial Aid Office.

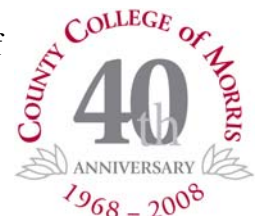
“This is a wonderful gift from the estate of a woman whose generosity and caring have benefitted, not only the County College of Morris, but her hometown of Randolph and the community at large,” said President Yaw. “Such a gift will allow us to expand our already impressive scholarship programs for those wishing to pursue a career in nursing.”

“Helen Bauer’s legacy in Randolph is that of a long time employee who helped to lay the foundation for the township’s recreation program,” said Randolph Mayor Allen M. Napoliello. “As Township Clerk, Helen took on the added duties of managing the township’s recreation (cont’d)

programs at a time when the township had a Recreation Committee but no Recreation Department. Because of its gratitude to Helen, the Recreation Committee has annually presented the Helen Bauer Volunteer of the Year Award to deserving individuals.”

Her husband, George W. Bauer, who died in 1999, served as director of general services at Dover General Hospital for 16 years before retiring in 1976. He also served in Randolph municipal government for many years. He was the town's mayor for two terms in the 1960s, and served at various times as police commissioner, fire and road commissioner, building inspector and on the board of adjustment.

Helen M. Bauer, who died in 2007, studied nursing at Mercy Hospital in Pittsburgh and worked for a time as a registered nurse. She married George Bauer in 1932 and lived in Randolph for 51 years, serving as town clerk from 1957 to 1975 before moving to Denville.
