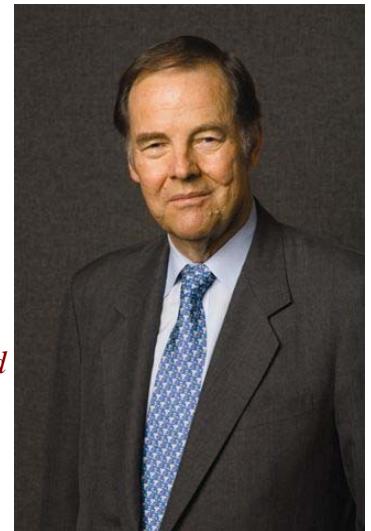

*The event will begin with a keynote address by our special guest*

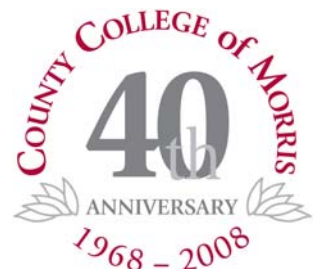
