Soccer team finishes 3rd in the nation

The men's soccer team at County College of Morris recently finished the season 3rd in the country. The team's overall record was 18-4. They won the Region XIX Championship and District Championship. The men travelled to Texas to compete in the NJCAA Final Four, the winner of which was crowned the National Champions. CCM lost to eventual National Champion Herkimer 2-1 in overtime of the first game. The Titans went on to defeat Manchester 4-2 in the consolation round to finish as the third best team in the country. This is the farthest any CCM men's soccer team has ever gone. Not only were the Titans outstanding on the field, they represented the college extremely well off the field, said Jack Sullivan, Athletic Director at CCM.

"Funny Girl" and "Rosemary's Baby" will be shown on Dec. 12.

- ◆ "Funny Girl" depicts the life of comedienne Fannie Brice, from her early days in the Jewish slums of the Lower East Side, to the height of her career with the Ziegfeld Follies, including her marriage to and eventual divorce from her first husband, Nick Arnstein.
- ◆ "Rosemary's Baby" is the tale of a young couple who move into a new apartment, only to be surrounded by peculiar neighbors and occurrences. When the wife becomes mysteriously pregnant, paranoia over the safety of her unborn child begins controlling her life.

On December 13, the festival will include "Midnight Cowboy" and "The Odd Couple."

- ◆ "Midnight Cowboy" is about a naive male prostitute and his sickly friend who struggle to survive on the streets of New York City.
- ◆ "The Odd Couple" is about two friends who try sharing an apartment, but their ideas of housekeeping and lifestyles are as different as night and day.
