40th Anniversary celebration lectures

"Modern Battles of Trenton"

Presenter - Robert Martin

CCM will host a free lecture chronicling major legislation, in New Jersey including gun control, school funding, civil unions, Highlands preservation and the repeal of the death penalty from 11:30 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. on March 3 in the Student Community Center Davidson Room. No reservation is necessary. The lecture will be presented by Robert Martin, a former legislator who served 23 years in the State Senate and General Assembly. He holds an advanced law degree from NYU, a doctorate from Columbia University, and is currently a professor at Seton Hall Law School and consultant to the Council of State Governments.
