CCM Installs Surveillance Cameras

The college is installing 168 interior and exterior surveillance cameras to deter crime and assist with safety and security on campus. They will be used in accordance with all state and federal rules and regulations. Placement of cameras will not violate your privacy. For example, cameras have not been placed in restrooms, locker rooms, or offices. The Department of Public Safety is responsible for reviewing activity on the cameras in accordance with college approved protocol.

Currently, 140 cameras have been activated. The remaining 28 will be activated over the next three weeks.

Astronaut to Visit CCM

Dr. Garrett Reisman, who flew aboard the Space Shuttle *Endeavor* last March, will speak about his mission and the importance of facilities such as the CCM Planetarium to America's science education.

During his three months in space about the International Space Station, Reisman performed one spacewalk totaling 7 hours and 1 minute and executed numerous tasks with the Space Station robotic arm and the new robotic manipulator, Dextre.

Dr. Reisman was born in Morristown and attended Parsippany High School.

Admission is FREE and open to the campus community.
