Update on H1N1 - A Message from President Yaw

As you know, national health authorities have announced that the United States may be facing an extensive outbreak of the H1N1 virus this fall. Although the virus is not expected to be unusually deadly, it may be widespread. County College of Morris, like all large institutions throughout our state and nation, must prepare. We have already begun that process by organizing an internal group of administrators to monitor the progress of the flu this fall and to take all appropriate steps to ensure a safe environment for our students, faculty and staff.

We are also working very closely with the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services, the Morris County Department of Health as well as the federal Centers for Disease Control (CDC) on directives and recommendations for preparing for, and dealing with, a possible outbreak.

The first step in our preparations was to establish a comprehensive communications plan that will keep the entire college community advised on breaking news and important information. We will be utilizing a number of communications channels to keep you informed. We've already established a "Flu Information Center" link on the Current Students page of our website www.ccm.edu. Clicking on that link will take the visitor to a dedicated page with news, information and health recommendations that will be updated and refreshed as needed. In addition, we will utilize global e-mails (when necessary), our weekly employee newsletter the CCMemo, the student newspaper *The Youngtown Edition* and student e-mails for conveying timely information and directives about H1N1 and CCM.
