Board to Consider Budget and Tuition Revisions at Next Board Meeting

The CCM Board of Trustees will consider approval of the college budget for fiscal year 2010-2011 and submission of the budget to the Board of School Estimate at the next board meeting to be held at 7 p.m., Wednesday, Jan. 20 in the Henderson Hall Board Room. The board will also consider revisions to the tuition policy, tuition rates, college fees and course fees. Prior to voting, the college community and community residents will have an opportunity to address the board.

Until the public hearing on Jan. 20, an itemized statement of the college budget, together with comparative data for the prior year, is on file and open to examination by the public in the Office of Business and Finance, County College of Morris, 214 Center Grove Road, Randolph Township, New Jersey from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
