Signing Agreement for CCM and the College of St. Elizabeth

County College of Morris and the College of St. Elizabeth signed a Joint Agreement on April 27 to allow students admitted to CCM’s associate in arts degree program in Communications or Journalism also to be admitted to the CSE’s baccalaureate program in Communication.

Upon graduation from CCM, students in the program will be able to take up to an additional 33 credits at the County College. The other remaining credits toward the bachelor’s degree would be selected from CSE’s courses, most of which will be offered at the CCM campus.

County College of Morris and the College of St. Elizabeth have similar joint agreements in Business Administration and Criminal Justice.

Supervisors of student employees, take note of these important dates:

- May 15 will be the LAST day of work for the academic year.
- May 17 will be the FIRST day of the summer student employment period.

Note: Only those students who have been officially hired/rehired for the summer employment period are permitted to work after May 15.

If your department would like to employ student aides this summer, read the following instructions and information carefully.

- Print and complete a Summer Student Aide Request Form; send it to Career Services (B-236). To access this form go to http://www3.ccm.edu/career_services/staff/StudentAideRequestFormSummer.pdf.
- Send students who want to work during the summer to Career Services before May 17.

In order for students to be hired or rehired for the summer remember that departments must have submitted request forms; and students must have registered for at least 6 credits for the fall semester at CCM.

Once a student's paperwork is complete, he/she will be given a Summer Work Assignment Form to give to you. Do not let a student work after May 15 unless the student has given you a Summer Work Assignment Form.

The shock, anger, and sadness that the world felt when four students were killed by the National Guard during a 1970 war protest on the campus of Kent State University in Ohio will hopefully never be repeated. For researchers, students, faculty, staff, and members of the community, the memories of that tragedy, both written and recorded, have been compiled by the Department of Special Collections and Archives of Kent State University. The May 4 Collection has its own website, which is comprised of such links as a table of "Contents", "Index", "Exhibits/Chronologies", "Oral History Project", and "History Day Help". The "May 4 Collection Contents" reveals that there are 211 boxes of papers, records, newspaper articles, photographs, radio recordings, and comic strips that constitute the May 4 Collection. The "Oral History Project" link explains the ongoing project of recording "first-person narratives and personal reactions to the events of May 4, 1970." It aims to record narratives of all viewpoints of those "whose lives were affected by these historical events."
