40 Year CCM Veteran Retires

This spring will mark the end of an era at CCM.

Robert Gebhardt, Professor of Mathematics and Astronomy, joined County College of Morris when it opened in the fall of 1968 – one of three dozen full-time faculty members.

Bob was hired to teach electronics technology courses. He had been teaching undergraduate and graduate electrical engineering courses at the City

College of New York, but the first course Bob taught at CCM was drafting for mechanical technology and electronics technology. Almost immediately he was made a mathematics professor and, upon the completion of the original planetarium in the early 1970s, an astronomy professor as well. During his years at CCM, Bob served as chairman of the Mathematics Department for five years, and then as assistant chairman for all the succeeding years.



After forty-two years at County College of Morris, Bob decided it was time for a change, from full-time faculty member to part-time faculty member, teaching some courses and tutoring students in the Math Center. Now, Bob will have time to pursue his additional interests, which have been postponed year after year. But he'll continue to pursue his first love - teaching.
