Presentations were given on Making Logical Sense of Language by Dr. Deborah Bennett of New Jersey City University, Statistics in Action: The Story of a Successful Service Learning Project by Dr. Mary DeHart of Sussex County Community College and 30 Centuries of Computation in a 21st-Century Format by Aggie Azzolino, a 1997 AMATYC (American Mathematics Association of Two-Year Colleges) Teaching Excellence Awardee.

During the business meeting, Louise was presented with a plaque for her many years of service to the organization.

Interesting Websites

Do you like words? Do you like learning about words? Do you have teens getting ready for the SAT/ACT? Check out this website for a "cool" graphical interface that deals with words and all you could hope to know about them. Use the scroll button to make the graphical interface larger and smaller. Visuwords <http://www.visuwords.com/> What would a visual graphical dictionary look like? The Visuwords website gives expression to such a concept, and it does so by producing diagrams reminiscent of a neural net. Upon entering the site, visitors will be presented with a random word, complete with various "connections". On the left-hand of the page, visitors can learn about the different coded connections which indicate relationships such as "is a part of" or "opposes" and parts of speech, such as "nouns", "verbs", or "adverbs". Of course, visitors are encouraged to type in their own word into the search query at the top of the page. Additionally, the home page contains some basic information about how to read these various graphical representations and how to most effectively use the interface system.
