Campus Renovations

Construction has begun for multiple academic complex renovation projects. The first, second and third-floor restrooms of Cohen and DeMare Halls will be completely renovated. DeMare Hall restrooms will be taken off-line first and their renovation completed prior to the start of the Cohen Hall restrooms. Also, the academic complex renovations will include the corridors of the second floor of Sheffield Hall, Cohen Hall, DeMare Hall, and the academic expansion areas one and two.

Renovations will take place on the HVAC systems in Cohen Hall, DeMare Hall, the LRC upper level, and the academic expansion areas one and two. During this period, contact the Plant & Maintenance Department for fans or if you have questions regarding the HVAC system.

The academic complex rooms will be re-numbered to resolve current wayfinding issues for students. The old signage will be removed and new signage installed with new room numbers and Braille equivalents to meet current accessibility standards.

The work will be completed as quickly as possible, with the intent to get the most disruptive work completed prior to the start of the fall semester. One building's restrooms and some of the HVAC work will extend into the fall semester due to the extensive work being done.

Construction will continue on the Landscape & Horticultural Technology building throughout the summer. There may be periodic detours on the roadway adjacent to the construction site during crane operations, geothermal well drilling and utility installations. Detour
