

CCM Adjunct Professor's Artwork to Appear at Group Show



Barbara Neibart, an adjunct assistant professor of fine arts at County College of Morris (CCM), will have her paintings displayed at a group show taking place at the College of Saint Elizabeth (CSE) from June 18 through September 22.

The show, titled *Nocturnes*, will be held in CSE's Therese A. Maloney Art Gallery and an opening reception will take place on June 18 from 4:30 – 7 p.m. in the gallery's annunciation center. The show, curated by Dr. Virginia Fabbri Butera, the gallery's director, will include works by 21

artists. The opening reception will also feature a piano concert. The gallery is located at 2 Convent Road, Morristown, and is open Wednesday through Sunday from 4 – 8 p.m.

Neibart's paintings are also currently on display at an exhibit in Venice, Italy, at Osteria alle Testiere.

Campus Connect Talks Fulbright During Remote Interviews

Dr. Edward J. Yaw, president of CCM and host of the TV program *Campus Connect*, recently discussed his participation in the Fulbright Community College Administrator's Seminar in Russia with two individuals he met during his visit. The conversations were able to take place with a little help from technology.

Yaw remotely interviewed both Dr. Joel Ericson, the director of the Fulbright Program in Russia, and J. David Armstrong, president of Broward College in Fort Lauderdale, FL, on the latest broadcast. Armstrong was one of four community college leaders who joined Yaw during the seminar. The group spent two weeks meeting with higher education and other officials in Kazan and Moscow, sharing ideas and insights about professional education, workforce development and the performing arts.
