Salary Authorization Memorandum to be Replaced

The Salary Authorization Memorandum (CCM-0132) is being discontinued and will be replaced by the Work Authorization Form for Stipend Payment (CCM-WAF). Use of the new form is required beginning August 1 and the old form will not be accepted after that date. Two important differences are:

1. The work being authorized may not begin until after the authorizations

Personal Benefit Statement Online

Your Personal Benefit Statement is now available through your personal account on the Member Benefits Online System (MBOS). The online statement presents the same information previously available on the paper statement. Online access is available to all eligible members of the Public Employees' Retirement System, Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund, Police and Firemen's Retirement System, and State Police Retirement System. In order to register on the MBOS system, PERS covered employees will need their PERS membership number. This number can be found on past PERS Personal Benefit Statements.
