### CCM Education Helps Company Win Edison Patent Award



When Glenbrook Technologies was notified it had won a 2013 Thomas Alva Edison Patent Award in the Medical Devices category, it was thanks to the work of two employees who attended County College of Morris (CCM).

The device, a one-of-a-kind rotating X-ray camera that observes the effectiveness of filters inside blood vessels, was developed by principal inventor Corry Tsang and production supervisor Daxesh Patel. Tsang, who has been with the Randolph-based company for 15 years, received his associate's degree in electrical engineering technology from CCM in 2000. Patel, who has been with Glenbrook Technologies for 16 years, also studied electrical engineering at CCM.

The award-winning apparatus was created to observe the effectiveness of vena cava filters, which capture blood clots traveling through the large vein that carries blood from the lower half of the body to the
