American Music Class in New Orleans Again this Spring



County College of Morris (CCM) once again this spring will be offering an American Music course in New Orleans, one of the nation's top music destinations.

This is the third year in a row that Todd Collins, professor of music at CCM, will be bringing students to New Orleans for his American Music course, also known as Music 291 (section number 40507).

The class, which is open to all individuals whether or not they are enrolled at CCM, takes place June 6–16 as part of the college's first Summer Sessions offerings.

As part of the course, participants will hear various types of music, take a cruise on the Natchez Riverboat, visit the Backstreet Cultural Museum, watch a concert at Preservation Hall, and tour the state museums Presbytere and the Cabildo, along with the United States Mint. Direct Deposit Required for Employees

All CCM employees are required to utilize direct deposit of pay no later than July 1. Forms are available from Payroll and Human Resources, as well as on Spider in the Human Resources section at <http://www3.ccm.edu/spider/pdf/CCMDirectDepositForm.pdf>. Employees are able to view their pay advices as follows:

- Go to www.ccm.edu and select the link to WebAdvisor under "Quick Links"
- Log in using the same user name and password as you would for your employee email
- Select the "Employees" tab (you will not be able to view your pay advice using other tabs)
- Under "Employee Profile" select "Pay Advices"
- Pay dates will be available for the current year
- To view pay advices from prior years, select the year desired from the "Select Other Year" pull-down menu
